Note that the reason I've got so many rugs - a horse outdoors is going in the UK to get wet a lot, which means that his rugs will get wet and filthy a lot as a result! So I have 2 x each weight of rug so that if one gets wet, the spare one can be used. This is the same with the Equichap close contact turnout chaps which is why I have 2 sets of 4 - one set can be bunged in the washing machine whilst the other set are being worn. Since my horse suffers badly from mud fever and doesn't get it at all when he wears these chaps it makes sense to make sure he has enough so that there is a pair he can wear when the others are in the wash!
